

## How to apply

### Eligibility

Any active Maryland 4-H youth age 13-18 (as of January 1st) may apply to be on the Maryland 4-H State Council.

### Step 1

Review the application package on the State Council website.

### Step 2

Create or update your 4-H resume and cover letter.

### Step 3

Upload your 4-H resume, application, cover letter, and a current photo of yourself to 4-H online before November 15th.

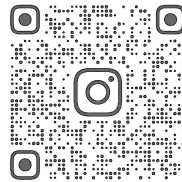

**Who we are...**

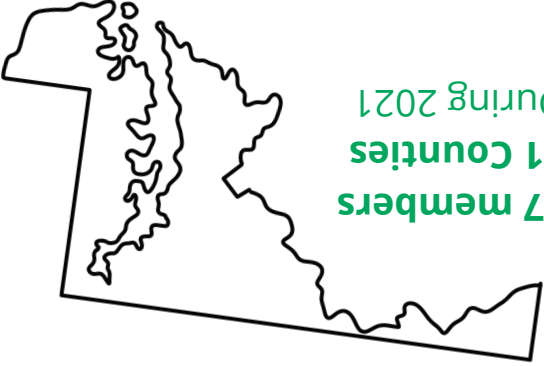
The Maryland 4-H State Council is the premier leadership opportunity for active 4-H members across the state who are interested in developing strong leadership skills.

Our mission as state council members is to promote 4-H across the state and engage with members of our community.

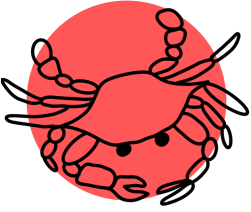
**Members all over Maryland**

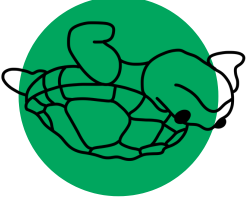

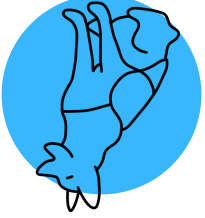
