Welcome to the 2023 4-H Youth Adventures Camp! This year's camp will take place at Frederick County 4-H Camp & Activities Center in Frederick, Maryland and will be held from July 31 - August 4, 2023.

In 2001 our camp won the Eleanor P. Eells Award from the ACA for program excellence. We were nominated for this award again for our 2002 camp and placed in the top five in the country.

4-H CAMP PACKING INFORMATION



Welcome to the 4-H Xtreme Teen Camping Trip!

Your participation in all scheduled programs, contributions to sessions, and friendly attitude will make this an exceptional four and a half day experience. You will meet new people, explore new ideas, share your interests, and speak out on issues that matter to you.

Who, When and Where?

The camp will take place at the Frederick County 4-H Camp & Activity Center, 13702 Basford Rd., Frederick, Maryland 21703, from July 31 - August 4, 2023. Youth between the ages of 9-13 (as of Jan. 1) are allowed to participate.

Transportation

A bus will be picking up and dropping off camp participants from E-Church. Please have someone bring and pick up from this location. You will not be allowed to leave your personal vehicle on the premises.

Directions

We'll be using a commercial bus. From **Washington DC** take the 495 north to exit 35 for I270 W to Hagerstown, MD. Take exit 52 to merge onto US-15 S/US-340 W toward Charles Town/Leesburg. Take a slight left onto US-15 S (signs for Leesburg). Turn right onto Mountville Rd. Turn left onto Basford Rd. Continue approximately 0.3 miles and turn right into Campground. The main building will be on your left. Park in the parking lot.

When You Arrive at E-Church

Parents/Guardian must check you in at the registration area before boarding the bus. All Medications must be turned in at the registration area. It is important to arrive on time because we will be leaving E-Church at 8:00 a.m. SHARP!

Cabin Living

Camp gives you a chance to experience all aspects of outdoor living. Camp participants will be housed with campers, counselors and adult staff. This is a great chance to get to know teens from other areas. Cabin changes cannot be granted during camp. While you are at camp remember that you represent yourself, your community and family. Treat all property with respect. Males and females are housed separately and teens are not permitted to visit the rooms of opposite sex participants. We will have cabin meetings at night to answer any questions about the next day and to help you solve any problems you may have encountered.

Special Needs

If you have any needs which require modifications in housing, meals, or program, please contact Ariel Delgado by **Friday July 21, 2023** with your requests so that appropriate accommodations can be made.

What to Bring

A checklist for camp is attached to this letter. **Leave items of value at home. The program is not responsible for items lost during camp.** Dress for camp is fun wear. You will need to bring bed linens, towels, and personal care items. Please be sure that everything you bring to camp is clearly marked with your name.

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How to Join 4-H to Participate in a 4-H Camp

Youth who want to participate in Maryland 4-H Camps must first join 4-H. Enrolling in 4-H is a quick and easy process using the **4-H Online** enrollment system. If you have questions about the enrollment process or how to use 4-H Online, contact your local 4-H office. There is a 4-H program office in each Maryland county and Baltimore City. To join 4-H so you can participate in a 4-H Camp, follow the steps below.

4-H Online Family Profile

You will need to create or access your family profile in 4-H Online. If someone in your family has participated in a Maryland 4-H activity in the past 5 years, you likely already have a 4-H Online family profile. If you are not sure how to access your existing family profile, contact your local 4-H office for assistance.

- If you do not have a 4-H Online family profile, start at **Step 1**.
- If you already have a 4-H Online family profile, start at **Step 2**.

1. Create your 4-H Online Family Profile

Click "Don't have an account?"

Follow the prompts to create your account:

- **State** - Select Maryland and click University of Maryland.

- **County** - Select the county where you live.*




If you live outside Maryland, **STOP and contact the 4-H office for the county/city where you would like to participate in Maryland 4-H. The local 4-H team will assist you.*

- **Create Your Account** - Provide your login and contact information.


*If the **Create Account** button does not activate, it means your email address already exists in a 4-H Online family profile. **STOP** and contact your local 4-H office for assistance with logging into your existing family profile.*

- **Verify Your Address** - Add your address and click **Verify**. Your address will be verified using the U.S. Postal Service database.

If you receive a **Duplicate Address: Account Recovery** message, **STOP** and contact your local 4-H office. This means there is already a family profile in 4-H Online that has your address. You may have an existing profile. Your local 4-H team can help you recover your existing profile or finish creating your new one.

Once your address is accepted, you will be prompted to add information for the first family member you want to enroll in 4-H. Click on the bar titled “4-H” to proceed. **Go to Step 3** of this guide to continue.



2. Log in to your 4-H Online Family Profile



Access your existing 4-H Online family profile by logging in at <https://v2.4honline.com>

- Your email is the one you used when you set up your family profile
- If you don't remember your password, you can reset it using the link under the **Sign In** button.

If you don't remember your email or password, contact your local 4-H office for assistance. They can help you recover your login information.

Once you have logged in, locate the name of the youth you want to enroll on the **Member List**. Click the **Enroll Now** link next to the name.

If the youth's name is not on the list, click the **Add Member** button to create a new member profile.


Youth Member Enrollment

To enroll a youth in 4-H **only** for the purposes of participating in a 4-H Camp, make the selections directed below. If the youth wants to participate in other 4-H clubs or programs in addition to 4-H Camp, refer to the **Youth Enrollment Guide** on the [Maryland 4-H website](#) or contact your local 4-H office for assistance.

3. Create a Youth Member Enrollment

Read the instructions for each section as you proceed through the enrollment screens. Complete each section as follows:

- **Units** – Select 4-H Camping – Prince George's County
- **Projects** – Select 4-H Camping
- **Questions** – Answer the questions about the youth member. Some answers will already be filled in. Questions tagged **required** must be answered to proceed to the next step.



- **Consents** – Read and sign the consents. You must mark the agreement statements and type in legal names to proceed to the next step.
- **Confirm** – Review and confirm information. Make changes using the **Back** button. Click **Submit** when complete.

The Maryland 4-H enrollment fee is waived for youth members joining 4-H **only** to participate in a 4-H Camp. You will not see a payment screen or be asked to enter payment card information unless you choose units or projects other than as directed above. If you wish to join other 4-H units or clubs, you will be directed to pay the enrollment fee when you submit your enrollment.

You will receive an email from the 4-H Online system confirming your enrollment was submitted.

Repeat this process for each youth family member who is joining 4-H to participate in a 4-H Camp. Use the **Add Member** button on the family **Member List** to enroll additional youth.

4. Enrollment Approval

After you submit your enrollment, it will be reviewed and approved by your local 4-H team. You will receive an email from the 4-H Online system confirming your enrollment was approved. You will also see the approved enrollment next to the youth's name on the Member List of your 4-H Online family profile.

Once your enrollment is approved, you can register for Maryland 4-H Camps. Follow the registration instructions for the camp you want to attend.

How to Register for an Event in 4-H Online

Prince George's County 4-H Camping Program

Registration for the 2022 Prince George's County 4-H Camping Program is completed through 4-H Online. 4-H members ages 9-13 (as of January 1) who wish to participate should follow the steps below.

To submit your 4-H Camp Staff Training registration, follow these steps:

1. Log in to 4-H Online

Sign into your family's 4-H Online profile using your family email and password.

If you forgot your password, you can reset it from the home screen. The reset link will be sent to the email address associated with your profile.

Your County 4-H Online Manager can also reset your password, if necessary.

Your profile will open to your family's **Member List**.

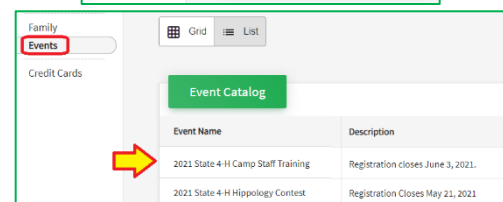
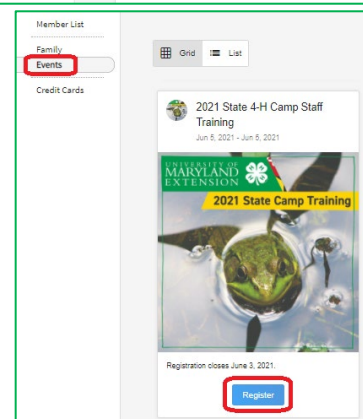
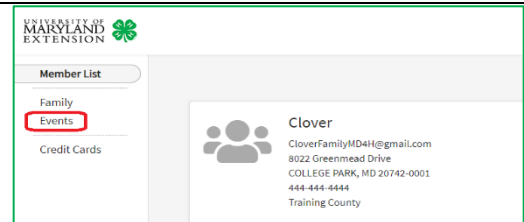


2. Locate the Event Registration

Click **Events** on the left sidebar.

When the Events page opens you will see the **Prince George's County 4-H Camp 2022** event information. Depending on the view setting you have chosen, it may display as a box with a graphic or on a list. You can change the view by clicking Grid or List at the top of the page.

To open the event, click the **Register** button (grid view) or click on the event name (list view).



3. Identify the Participant

The Family Member list will display all members of your family who are enrolled for the current year. Identify the member who is registering by clicking to highlight their name on the list.

Click the **Select** button to continue.




4. Choose the Member's Participant Type

The participant type will display based on the member's eligibility.

Click **Start Registration** to proceed.

NOTE: Only 4-Hers ages 12-18 as of January 1, 2021 are eligible to attend the 4-H Camp Staff Training. If you select a 4-Her who is not old enough to attend, no participant type will display and you will not be able to start the registration.



5. Complete the Event Registration



There are three steps to this event registration:

Read the **Event Information** at the top of the page.

Answer the questions in the **Registration** section.

When you have answered all registration questions, click the **Next** button to continue.

6. Sign the Consent

Once you have read the consent, type the required name(s) into the signature fields at the bottom.

Click the bubble next to the agreement statement.

Click **Next** to continue.

8. Confirmation and Processing

After you submit the registration you will be returned to the **Events** page of the member profile. You will see the event name displayed, and your entry status as **Pending Approval**.

You will also receive an email verifying that your registration was received.

Your registration is not complete until it is approved. Your registration will be reviewed by the Event Manager at the State 4-H Office before it is approved. If the Event Manger finds a discrepancy in your registration, they may send it back to you for correction and resubmittal. You will be notified by email if your registration is sent back.

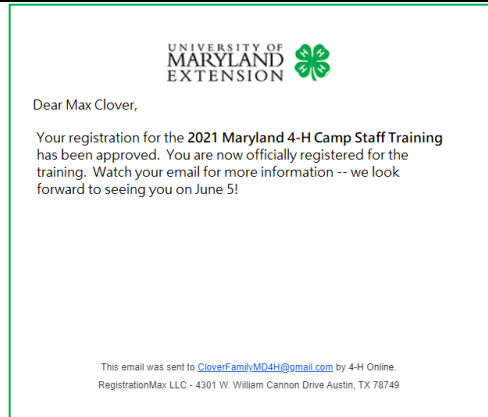

You will need to join Teen Academy before your registration can be approved. When you join Teen Academy you will purchase the materials you will need for this training. The fee for Teen Academy is \$25.00. Look for more information in your email inbox.

Once the State 4-H Event Manager has approved your registration, you will receive an email confirming your registration is complete.

You will be notified by email each time an action is taken on your registration. You can also check your registration status on the **Events** tab of your member profile in 4-H Online. To view your registration status, follow the steps described in the next section (Step 10).



9. Finishing an Incomplete Registration

If you start an event registration but do not finish it, you can return to it later. To access an incomplete registration, go to your family's Member List and click the blue **View** button next to the member's name. The member profile will open.

Click the **Events** tab on the left sidebar. A list of all events the member has accessed will display. You will see the registration status for the 2021 4-H Camp Staff Training is **Incomplete**.

Click on the event name to open the registration page. You can then resume registration from where you left off.

NOTE: You will not be able to finish/submit an incomplete registration after the registration deadline has passed.
