



Clover Record Book Guidelines

You will need a standard record book cover. These are available at the Extension Office. Once you purchase your first cover, you will use it over again every year.

The first page in your book is the “Title” page. It contains a portrait type picture of the 4-H member along with Name, Address, 4-H Age, County and Club.

After that, include the “My 4-H Clover Book” pages found on the county website, <https://extension.umd.edu/locations/queen-annes/local-4-h-youth-education>

When you write your “My 4-H Story”, feel free to use more paper. The stories compete for the “Michael Cohey Jr. Memorial Story Award” which looks for the enthusiasm and love of 4-H which young Michael possessed before passing away as a Clover aged 4-Her.

You may also have additional pages of pictures and artwork.
